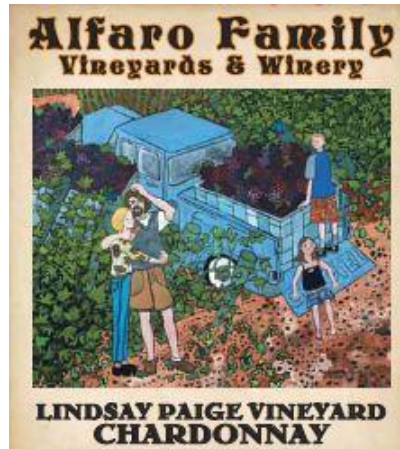


2017 “Lindsay Paige Vineyard” Estate Chardonnay



The Vineyard:

Founded in 1998 by Richard and Mary Kay Alfaro, Alfaro Family Vineyards is dedicated to the production of estate bottled Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. This Chardonnay comes from a 3.5 acre own-rooted vinifera block of the Wente clone planted in 1998. A small amount of the Musque clone #809 of Chardonnay is included in the blend to add complexity. The soil type is sandy and gravelly loam.

The Vintage:

The fruit developed full ripe flavors while retaining excellent natural acidity. Cool conditions were predominant except for a 3 day heat spike, where temperatures reached 108 degrees. Yields were average. The grapes were harvested on October 3, 2017.

The Wine:

From our flagship vineyard, this Chardonnay is rich with flavor and has a long, lush finish. Hazelnuts and white flowers lead to pure pear and apple fruit, with touches of mineral, honey and vanilla. Aged for 8 months in 30% new French oak, 189 cases produced.
